MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS CORI Forms

It's that time of year when volunteers in the parish must complete an annual Cori.

If you are an Usher, Alter Server, Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Teacher, Musician, in the Choir, the Knight of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul, or a Prayer Group, you must fill out an annual Cori form.

You may obtain a form from your ministry leader or obtain one at the parish office. If you live in New Hampshire, you will need to fill and additional Cori for NH.

Please fill out the form(s) as soon as possible and <u>bring</u> them to the parish office along with your ID at 11 Sparhawk St., Amesbury, Monday - Thursday from 9am-2pm or you may give them to Terry Beecroft, Don Beaulieu or Father after mass.

Anyone who has not completed or passed a CORI form in *Will Not* be allowed to volunteer in any capacity for the parish. This is a **mandatory** requirement from the Archdiocese.
